Waridihome scholarship Program

Five boys joined Msambweni Secondary School this year, 2015. They were sponsored by WaridiHome through KidsCare. They were provided with full school fees, textbooks and mattresses. These boys who are from KidsCare assisted households are happy for their new life in boarding secondary school.

Waridi home has increased the number of sponsored children

5 boys - Msambweni Boys Secondary School
3 girls - Ngozi Girls Secondary School
8 students - Mrima Polytechnique



KidsCare in collaboration with Dream Achiever Youth Organization

...are implementing the Dance for Life program. The program uses 'world starts with me', curricular, this is a digital program that seeks to offer self awareness education in an audio visual participative way. The youth empowerment pilot program targets neighbouring Mshiu, Bwiti and Mwangwei primary schools. These students come to the centre every 1st, 2nd, 3rd Saturdays of the month to interact with the trained KidsCare Social team.

Shelter is a priority need to our households in Mwamtsefu. This household has resolved to construct iron sheet roofed house which is more durable than the makuti thatched house. HomeCare program is realizing visible results as most families are using the cash transfer support from KidsCare to implement this fundamental aim set to change their livelihood.

KidsCare is extending its present HomeCare Program and bringing this program closer to the families in need. KidsCare targets to open 6 outreach offices in each of its Location by end of 2015. In July 2015, Kikoneni, Lungalunga and Dzombo outreach offices opened its doors.
